IIMA Archives Catalogue





The Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad (IIM-A) was founded in 1961 as a unique collaboration between the Government of India, Government of Gujarat, local industrialists of Ahmedabad, Ford Foundation and the Harvard Business School, and has emerged as a world-class management institute. The IIMA Archives, formally launched in August 2019, preserves institutional memory and periodically disseminates historical information about the institute to the IIMA community and the general public. It holds a large collection of physical and digitized documents related with the foundation and evolution of the institute. The IIMA Oral History project is a key initiative of IIMA Archives that captures the experiences of several people associated with the institute from its formative years. IIMA Archives also holds a collection of documents, oral histories and directories related to the business and economic history of India.

Information on the history of IIMA is also available at the Ford Foundation Archives, Harvard Business School Archives and Louis Kahn Archives in USA.

IIMA Archives is open to the general public for research and the access policy is described at the end of this document.

Access Policy

IIMA Archives strives to facilitate a researcher-friendly environment. Most of the collection is available for physical or digital inspection at the archives. Users have to fill out a request form at the Archive before access. Email requests for specific files are also entertained, preferably after at least one visit to the archive.

The items with restricted access and the access policy for them are as follows:

Cases & Technical Notes: All the cases are available through purchase at the following website- https://cases.iima.ac.in/. The case catalogue spreadsheet is available on the IIMA Archives website.

IIMA Institution Building (1961-64) files: These are three bound volumes of copies of hundreds of letters. Researchers can select pages of interest which IIMA Archives can send across by email- Not more than 50 in number, per researcher. More pages can be accessed with due permission from the IIMA Archives Committee.

Minutes of Meetings files: Following a 25-year restriction, these are accessible to researchers outside IIMA for records before the year 1995 and are available for research only at the IIMA Archives.

Oral History Transcripts: Restricted transcripts cannot be sent by email and can only be viewed at the archives.

Terms and conditions for using archival material:

- 1. IIMA Archives must be credited for the use of its records (documents, images, audio-visual recordings, textual or electronic)
- 2. All permissions to the use of these records are granted on a one-time basis only. Any subsequent use of them will require a second letter of permission.
- 3. They must not be altered with in any way. They must not be duplicated or reproduced for sale, loaned to or deposited with another individual or repository without the prior written consent of IIMA Archives.
- 4. Please note that some of these records may be copyrighted and it is your responsibility to ensure that prior permission is obtained from the rightful copyrighted owner before making use of these records in any way.
